

NEIGHBORHOOD ALERTS

The Richmond Heights Police Department uses the All-Call Notification System to provide residents with a recorded message about community-related matters such as crime notifications and community events. KNOX-BOX & SMOKE DETECTORS

For residents with mobility issues, the Fire Department offers Knox-Boxes to help in case of an emergency. This box enables emergency responders to enter your residence if you are unable to get to the door. Residential Knox-Boxes can be purchased through the Fire department 24-hours a day.



The Richmond Heights Fire Department distributes free smoke detectors to city residents who need them. Firefighters will install them for residents who cannot do it themselves, and they will arrange to change smoke detector (and carbon monoxide detector) batteries for residents who need assistance.
